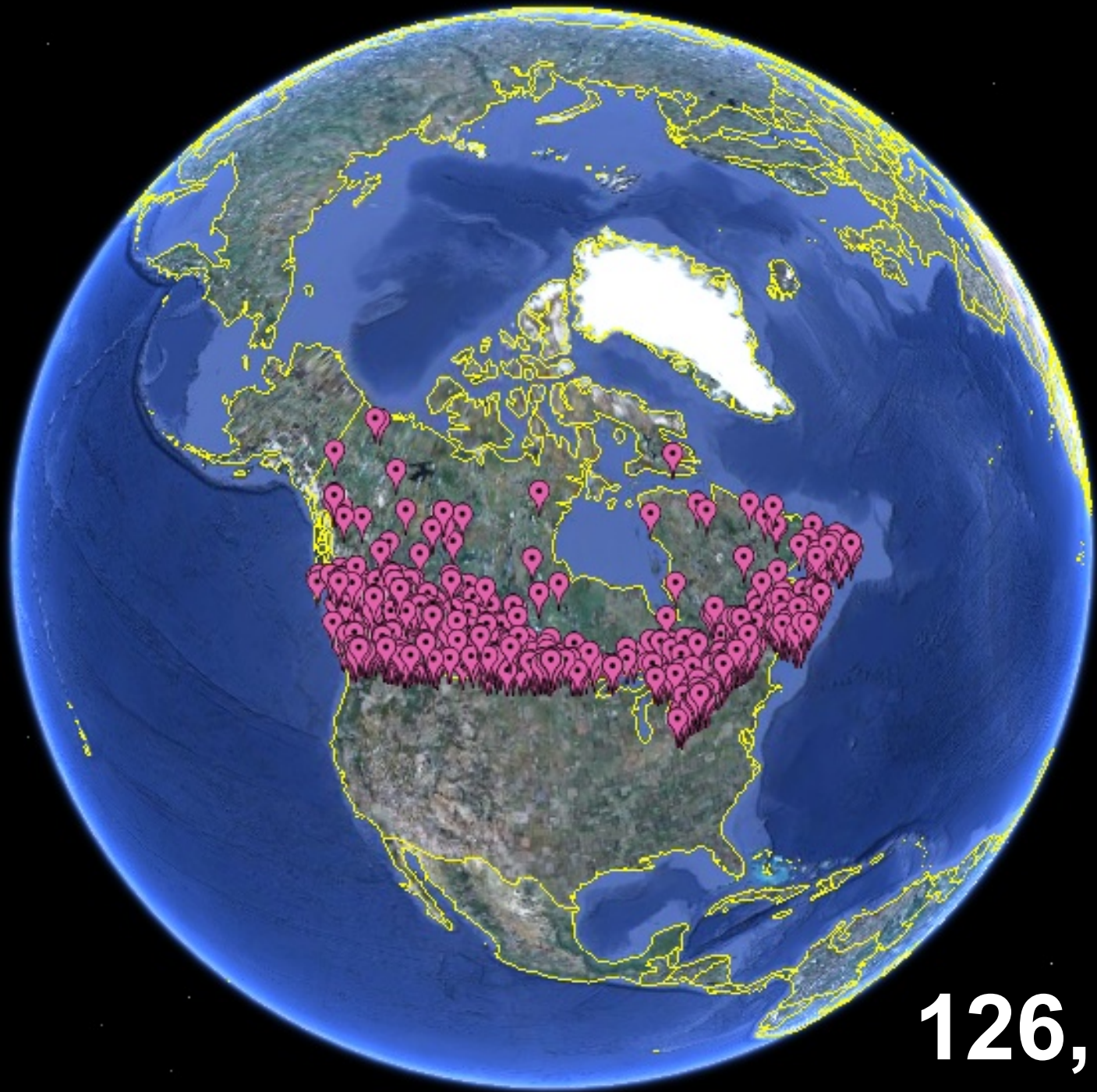

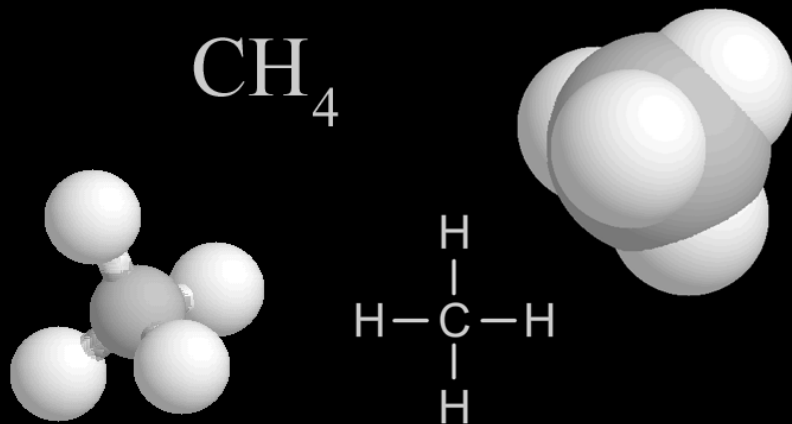

In the last few days a group of provinces have taken a powerful stand against the Conservatives' cruel Crime Bill.
